SCHOOL UNIFORM



Please be reminded that, upon returning to school in September, all pupils will be expected to wear correct uniform:

- Sensible black school shoes for girls (canvas shoes/ flimsy ballet shoes / trainers are not appropriate)
- For PE pupils require a house coloured t-shirt and trainers for outdoor activities.
- Girls must have long hair tied back and boys should not have patterns shaved into their hair or have Mohawk hair styles.
